ABOUT US

Refuge Host Homes serves any pregnant woman in crisis, age 18 and older, who needs safe, supportive housing in order to carry her baby to full term and to be equipped for the challenges of motherhood. Each mother stays in the Host Home through the remainder of her pregnancy and postpartum period, until baby is about 6 months old. If continued support is desired, she can then transition into our Independent Supportive Housing phase, where she will be able to rent an apartment in an apartment owned by a Restorative Landlord who helps her to grow towards dignified independence. Monthly rent assistance is provided through our Partner Churches.
